

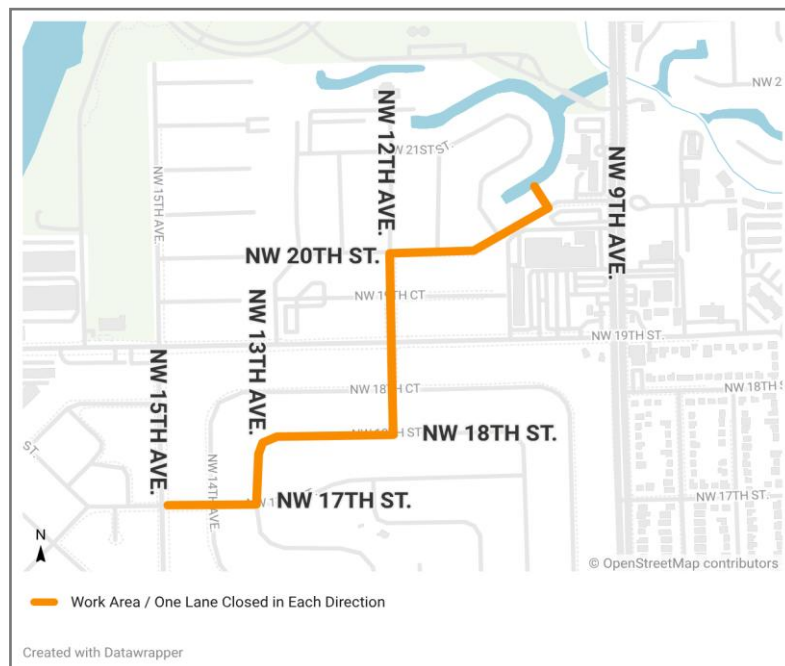

STORMWATER PIPE CLEANING & INSPECTIONS IN LAUDERDALE MANORS

The City of Fort Lauderdale is working with FloTech Environmental to clean and inspect stormwater pipes in Lauderdale Manors along:

- NW 20th Street from NW 12th Avenue to NW 9th Avenue
- NW 12th Avenue from NW 20th Street to NW 18th Street
- NW 18th Street from NW 12th Avenue to NW 13th Avenue
- NW 13th Avenue from NW 18th Street to NW 17th Street
- NW 17th Street from NW 13th Avenue to NW 15th Avenue

Work will begin on Monday, May 18, 2026, and take place on weekdays between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., starting at NW 9th Avenue and heading southwest toward NW 15th Avenue. Completion is expected in June 2026. This schedule is subject to changing circumstances.



Neighborhood Impacts

- Crews will access stormwater pipes through manholes to clean them and record videos within the pipes to document their condition.
- The roadway will not be disturbed and minimal noise is expected.

Traffic Impacts

- One lane along the streets listed above may be closed daily during work hours.
- Traffic control personnel will direct traffic as needed.
- Please follow posted signs and drive with caution in the area.
