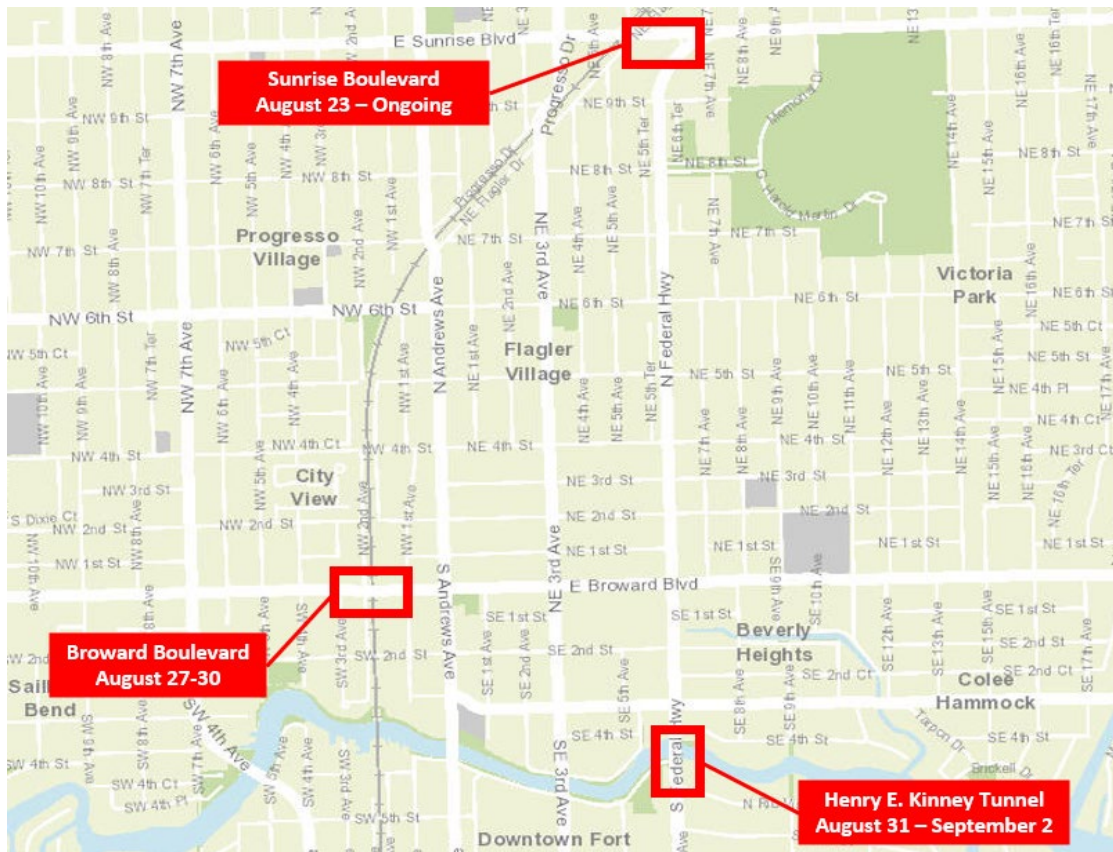

Re: Upcoming Road Closures within FDOT Right-of-Way

This memorandum shall serve as an update on upcoming major road closures related to projects within the Florida Department of Transportation’s (FDOT) right-of-way.

Dates of Impact & Location:

- August 23 – Ongoing: Sunrise Boulevard near US-1
- August 27 – August 30: Broward Boulevard @ FEC Railroad
- August 31 – September 2: Henry E. Kinney Tunnel



Additional Information:

Sunrise Boulevard:

- FDOT will commence work at West Sunrise Boulevard between the FEC Railroad tracks and North Federal Highway/US-1 on Tuesday, August 23, 2022, for general right-of-way improvements including new medians, installation of a new westbound turn lane on Sunrise Boulevard, and pavement marking and sign upgrades.
 - Daytime traffic impacts should be minimal and restricted to partial road or sidewalk closures.
 - Any full road closures will be done during nighttime hours of 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM to minimize impacts to local traffic.
 - Closures will be coordinated with City staff and the Henry E. Kinney Tunnel Top project.

Broward Boulevard:

- The Florida East Coast Railway (FEC) will be closing Broward Boulevard for approximately four days beginning Saturday, August 27, 2022, at 6:00 PM for general railroad maintenance.
 - Eastbound traffic will be detoured south on SW 7 Avenue/Avenue of the Arts to head east on SW 6 Street towards South Andrews Avenue.
 - Westbound traffic will be detoured north on North Andrews Avenue to head west on NW 4 Avenue towards NW 7 Avenue/Avenue of the Arts.
 - FEC will also advertise an alternative detour option to I-95 via Davie Boulevard.

Henry E. Kinney Tunnel:

- FDOT will be closing the Henry E. Kinney Tunnel/US-1 for two days beginning Wednesday, August 31, 2022, at 6:00 AM to pour the concrete deck for the Tunnel Top Pedestrian Plaza extension.
 - North and southbound traffic will be detoured to SE 3 Avenue from East Broward Boulevard and SE 7 Street.
 - FDOT will also advertise an alternative route option via Davie Boulevard.

City staff will continue to coordinate closely with FDOT and their construction teams to mitigate traffic impacts and assist with public outreach. For additional information, please contact Ben Rogers, Director of Transportation and Mobility, at BRogers@fortlauderdale.gov.
