

Retirement Benefits Checklist for IAFF Employees Participating in the City of Fort Lauderdale Police & Firefighters' Retirement System

The Pension Office administers only your monthly pension benefits so you will need to coordinate other aspects of your retirement with other departments within the City:

- **Accrued Leave Time Payouts** – Contact your timekeeper to coordinate any payouts or use of vacation prior to your retirement date.
- **Supplemental Health Benefit (Stipend)** – You must contact the Benefits Division regarding your eligibility for a benefit stipend designed to help subsidize the cost of health insurance. Those eligible for the stipend will receive it through their VEBA account (IAFF).
- **Continuation of Health Insurance** – The Pension Office will facilitate by providing you with an enrollment form to authorize premium deductions of retiree medical, dental and vision insurance from your monthly pension payment. **Contact Benefits Division for questions regarding insurance.**

- **City and/or Additional Life Insurance**– You may convert your life insurance to an individual policy with The Standard (888-937-4783). You must apply and pay the first premium within 60 days following your retirement.
- **Flexible Spending Account (FSA)**– You may not rollover your FSA through TASC (800-422-4661) to retiree coverage. Your options are to either spend out any remaining balance prior to the end of the month in which you retire or elect to continue FSA coverage under COBRA, which is also administered by TASC.
- **Aflac Plans** – You have the option to convert or port your AFLAC coverages to an individual policy. You must apply and pay the first premium directly to AFLAC within 31 days following your retirement. Contact AFLAC at 800-433-3036.
- **Deferred Compensation Plans** – If you participated in the optional deferred compensation plans provided by Nationwide or MissionSquare and you will need to contact the representatives of your respective plan identified below.
