Re: Streetlight Outages

The City of Fort Lauderdale has approximately 18,000 streetlights, with the majority (over 14,500) owned and maintained by Florida Power & Light (FPL). The City is responsible for the maintenance of roughly 3,200 streetlights. Streetlight outages can result from a variety of causes, including but not limited to burnt bulbs, blown fuses, damaged wiring, adverse weather, construction activities, and physical damage to poles and fixtures from vehicle accidents or vandalism.

There are multiple areas across the City that currently have streetlight outages. Efforts are underway with FPL and City crews to address these issues as quickly as possible. The areas impacted are highlighted below:
