**Re: Metropolitan Planning Organization Complete Streets and Other Localized Initiatives Cycle 8 and Cycle 9 Updates**

The City was notified that two grant applications submitted to the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Complete Streets and Other Localized Initiatives (CSLIP) Grant Program have advanced towards funding.

The City's 2023 Cycle 8 application for the NE 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue Mobility Project between Sunrise Boulevard and the South Fork of the Middle River has been programmed for design in Fiscal Year 2028 through the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) Tentative Work Program. The NE 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue project includes enhanced bike lanes, new and enhanced crosswalks, extended landscape medians, and raised intersections at various locations. In Cycle 8, FDOT programmed two of the nineteen eligible projects. Construction funding for the NE 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue project is anticipated to be planned for Fiscal Year 2031.

Additionally, on December 12, 2024, the MPO Board voted to approve the ranking of Cycle 9 CSLIP Grant Program projects. The City's South Middle River Mobility Project was ranked as number one out of the fourteen projects submitted by municipalities across the County, and it is recommended for funding. The project includes new sidewalks, ADA ramps, and traffic calming through raised intersections and speed humps in the South Middle River neighborhood. This project will be further vetted by the MPO and FDOT, and if approved, the project is anticipated to be programmed for design in Fiscal Year 2031.
