

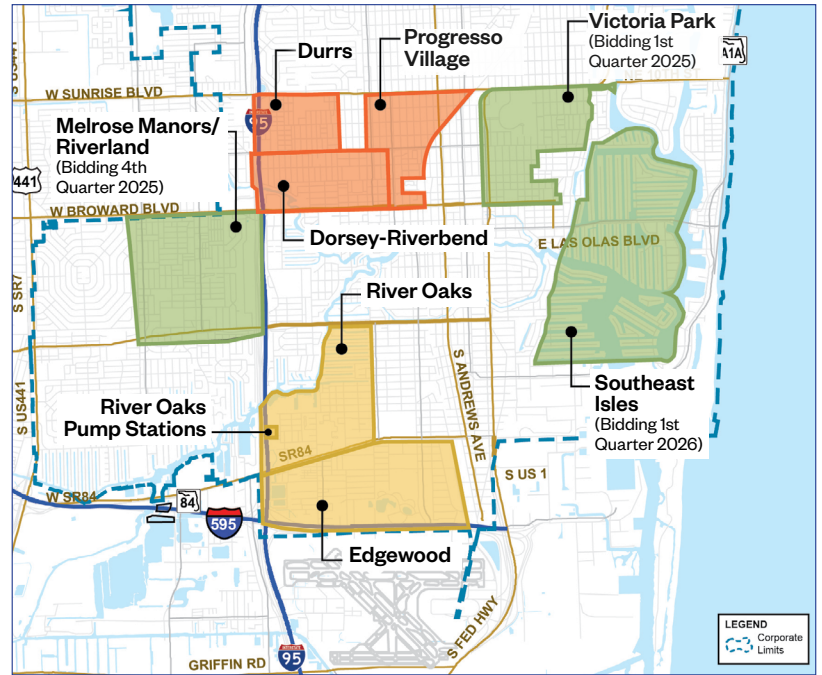
## Work on the Stormwater/Resilience Master Plan continues to progress throughout vulnerable neighborhoods in the City

Updated project progress for Tranche 1 and Tranche 2 neighborhoods is provided below. Work continues on planning efforts associated with the Tranche 2 neighborhoods, including updates to the City's existing and proposed stormwater model, allowing simulation of current and future conditions to guide stormwater improvements.

## Tranche 2 First Round of Public Outreach Meetings Conclude: Resident Input to Shape Project Design

The first round of neighborhood public outreach meetings concluded in January 2025, when sessions were held for projects in Flagler Village, Melrose Park, Imperial Point, Middle River Terrace, South Middle River and Lake Ridge. A [virtual meeting](#) was held in February for anyone who missed their respective neighborhood meeting. Participants provided valuable input that will be incorporated into the design of future stormwater infrastructure improvement projects.
