



### INFLOW & INFILTRATION REDUCTION PROGRAM: SEWER SMOKE TESTING

The City of Fort Lauderdale is working with Ardurra Group Inc. to conduct smoke testing throughout Fort Lauderdale over the next three years. This common procedure involves blowing smoke through sewer pipes to locate defects that would allow stormwater and groundwater to enter the sewer system.

The smoke being used is odorless, non-toxic, non-staining, does not create a fire hazard and will clear within 30 minutes with proper ventilation. Smoke should not enter private properties if they are properly plumbed and vented and if water traps contain water. If smoke enters private property, please ventilate the area, and notify nearby field technicians.

Smoke testing will take place Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. This schedule is subject to change based on inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

- Sewer Basin B-3 in Lauderdale Beach
- Sewer Basin B-16 in Central Beach
- Sewer Basin B-17 on NE 14 Ave from NE 53 St to NE 63 St

##### Monday, April 28, 2025 to Tuesday, April 29, 2025

- Sewer Basin E-3 in Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport Hangars

##### Wednesday, April 30, 2025

- Sewer Basin B-23 in Port Royale, Bay Colony Club, and Montego Bay

##### Thursday, May 1, 2025 to Friday May 2, 2025

- Sewer Basin B-2 in Galt Mile and Bermuda Riviera

##### Monday, May 5, 2025

- Sewer Basin E-6 in Palm-Aire Village East

##### Tuesday, May 6, 2025

- Sewer Basin A-26 in N Gordon Rd
- Sewer Basin A-98 on W Broward Blvd from NW 22 Ave to NW 25 Ave

#### Traffic Impacts

- One lane in each direction of each street may be closed during work hours.
- Traffic control personnel will direct traffic as needed.
- Access to driveways will be maintained.
- Please follow posted signs and drive with caution in the area.
