The City of Fort Lauderdale was allocated \$88,051,000 in Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds under Public Law (P.L.) 118-158 for long-term recovery from major storms and flooding events that occurred in 2023 and 2024. In accordance with the Universal Notice, published in the *Federal Register* on January 8, 2025 (90 FR 1754), and the Allocation Announcement Notice, published in the *Federal Register* on January 16, 2025 (90 FR 4759), Fort Lauderdale's Action Plan associated with these funds is required to be submitted to HUD on or before April 21, 2025. Also consistent with the Notices, the City of Fort Lauderdale requested an extension to the deadline until July 21, 2025.

The Department has reviewed your request, and after considering the reasons outlined in your letter, the extension request for submittal of the Action Plan is granted until July 21, 2025.

The Department remains committed to assisting the City of Fort Lauderdale in its efforts to address long-term recovery and mitigation needs following the 2023 and 2024 events and looks forward to working with you and your staff to achieve this goal.
