**SUBJECT: Annual Consumer Confidence Report - Update**

As required by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP), community water systems must prepare and deliver the Calendar Year (CY) 2024 Consumer Confidence Report (CCR), also known as the annual Water Quality Report, to every water customer by July 1, 2025.

In March 2025, the Florida Rural Water Association (FRWA) in conjunction with the FDEP, issued guidance titled "Instructions and Template for the Consumer Confidence Reports, due by July 1, 2025". Public Works Utilities division staff coordinated with FDEP to complete the table of analytes to be included as part of the CCR.

Staff also coordinated with the Strategic Communications division to communicate this report to the public. As a result, the City of Fort Lauderdale's 2024 CCR will be published online at [www.fortlauderdale.gov/wqr](http://www.fortlauderdale.gov/wqr) along with instructions to obtain a paper copy by mail. Customers will be notified of the availability of the new CCR through social media, email notifications, FLTV, local newspapers, and utility bill messages.

Other regulatory requirements of the CCR include coordination with neighboring municipalities that the City sells bulk wholesale water to (Oakland Park, Wilton Manors, sections of Davie and Tamarac, and Port Everglades) and completion of the Certificate of Delivery Forms. These actions will be conducted in accordance with established EPA and FDEP procedures. The City of Fort Lauderdale will conclude this effort by submitting a 2024 certification package to FDEP by September 2025, as per Florida Administration Code FAC 62-555.
