**SUBJECT: Automated School Zone Speed Detection Camera Program –
Update #2**

This memorandum updates Memorandum No. 25-048, dated May 6, 2025.

The Procurement Services Division, in coordination with the Transportation and Mobility Department and the Police Department, has revised the Request for Proposals (RFP) for the Automated School Zone Speed Detection Camera Program. Key revisions include:

- Requiring the Successful Proposer to reimburse the City for traffic studies and data collection supporting site evaluations;
- Requiring all Proposers to provide a clear, itemized disclosure of all fees - processing, financial, transaction, merchant, administrative - in addition to the citation fee;
- Clarifying that the Successful Proposer must deploy enforcement equipment on at least two approaches per school zone; and
- Expanding the potential installation list from 29 to 38 schools, including private institutions.

RFP #483-3 was issued on July 1, 2025, with an initial closing date of August 1, 2025. The deadline was extended to August 8, 2025 via Addendum No. 1 to allow staff to review the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) updated School Zone Speed Detection System Placement and Installation Specifications, effective July 21, 2025.

Addenda Nos. 2 and 3 further instructed proposers on addressing the revised FDOT specifications. Addenda No. 4 extended the closing date from August 15th (pursuant to Addendum No. 2) to August 29, 2025, to provide additional time for proposers to amend their responses accordingly.
