



Notice: Upcoming Improvements

SEWER SYSTEM REHABILITATION: INFLOW & INFILTRATION REDUCTION PROGRAM

The City of Fort Lauderdale is working with LMK Pipe Renewal to make improvements to the City's sewer system in areas where inspections and smoke testing have identified minor defects. The project will start with crews sending cameras into the sewer system to check its condition before and after repairs. They'll also install new access points called cleanouts, replace or fix short sections of sewer pipes that connect properties to the main sewer line and make repairs inside manholes.

What to Expect

Work will take place on weekdays between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. No heavy machinery will be on site and minimal noise is expected as sewer lines will be accessed through manholes. Some work may require access to private property. Crews will coordinate directly with neighbors when this is necessary.

Traffic Impacts

- Temporary lane closures are expected along neighborhood streets during work hours.
- Traffic control personnel will direct traffic as needed.
- Access to driveways will be maintained.
- Please follow posted signs and drive with caution in the area.

Approximate Schedule

Mon., Sept. 22 – Fri., Oct. 17

- Sewer Basin A7 in Progresso Village, City View Townhomes, Flagler Village, Downtown Fort Lauderdale, Sailboat Bend and Beverly Heights
- Sewer Basin A13 in Victoria Park, Beverly Heights and Colee Hammock
- Sewer Basin A18 in Historic Dorsey Riverbend

Work is expected to be completed in April 2026. This schedule is subject to change based on inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
