**SUBJECT: Breakers Avenue Notice of Award -  
Broward County Surtax Municipal Grant Match**

I am pleased to announce that the City received a Notice of Award in the amount of \$3 million for the Breakers Avenue Resiliency and Traffic Improvements project from the Broward County Surtax Municipal Grant Match Program.

On May 6, 2025, the City Commission approved a Grant Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the Construction of the Breakers Avenue Resiliency and Pedestrian Traffic Improvements Project in the Amount of \$3 million. Additionally, the City received an \$850,000 appropriation from United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (pending City Commission approval).

On June 30, 2025, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 25-114 approving and authorizing the execution of the 2025 Amended and Restated Transportation System Surtax Interlocal Agreement (Third Amendment) with Broward County. The Third Amendment established a Grant Match Program (GMP) that allows municipalities to seek transportation surtax funding as part of the local match requirements for competitive state and federal programs, grants, and appropriations.

GMP funding is available on a first-come, first-serve basis for eligible projects. As part of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2026 cycle, the total available funding through the GMP is \$13 million, with a maximum project award of \$3 million, as established by Broward County. Municipalities are restricted to one (1) GMP application per fiscal year. Through the diligent effort of our Transportation and Mobility Department, the City of Fort Lauderdale was the first municipality to apply on August 18, 2025, the first day of the application cycle, and successfully secured \$3 million. GMP funding will be released in the County's FY2026 funding cycle through an Interlocal Agreement (ILA).

This award furthers the City's efforts in securing necessary funding to deliver the Breakers Avenue project. Currently, the 100% design plans are being reviewed by FDOT and

Broward County. City staff anticipates issuing an Invitation to Bid for the construction of the project in early 2026.
