Ms. Williams:

The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is pleased to advise you that it is approving the City of Fort Lauderdale’s Action Plan for Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds appropriated by Disaster Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2025 Public Law 118-158. On December 21, 2024, the Department allocated \$88,051,000 to the City of Fort Lauderdale for the purpose of assisting in long-term recovery from major disasters that occurred in 2023 and 2024.

Consistent with the December 21, 2024, notice, the City of Fort Lauderdale submitted the CDBG-DR Action Plan to HUD on October 13, 2025, which includes activities to assist in long-term recovery from major disasters. Subsequently, at the Department’s request, the City of Fort Lauderdale submitted revisions on November 13, 2025, which addressed all *Federal Register* notice requirements for approval and must be made available to the public via the grantee’s website. Posting the Action Plan gives the public and other key stakeholders the opportunity to review how funds will be used.

The Action Plan proposes several projects and programs that meet the requirements of the *Federal Register* notice. The list of CDBG-DR funded programs and respective budgets are in the CDBG-DR Disaster Allocation Table below.
