



### SEWER SYSTEM REHABILITATION IN TARPON RIVER & DOWNTOWN FORT LAUDERDALE

The City of Fort Lauderdale is working with Inliner Solutions to make improvements to the City's sewer system in areas of Tarpon River and Downtown Fort Lauderdale where inspections and smoke testing have identified minor defects. This project includes:

- Documenting sewer system conditions before and after repairs using cameras
- Installing new access points (cleanouts)
- Replacing or repairing short sections of pipe that connect properties to the main sewer line
- Making repairs inside manholes

Work will begin on Tuesday, May 26, 2026, and take place on weekdays between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Completion is expected in early 2027. This schedule is subject to change based on inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

#### What to Expect

No heavy machinery will be on site, and minimal noise is expected as sewer lines will be accessed through manholes. Some work may require access to private property. Crews will coordinate directly with neighbors when this is necessary.

#### Traffic Impacts

- Temporary lane closures are expected along neighborhood streets during work hours.
- Traffic control personnel will direct traffic as needed.
- Access to driveways will be maintained.
- Please follow posted signs and drive with caution.
