

Upcoming Water Service Maintenance

Wednesday 5/27 at 11:00 PM – Thursday, 5/28 at 7 AM

May 21, 2026 – There will be planned maintenance to the water distribution system during the timeframe listed above. Properties in the affected area may experience low water pressure while crews perform this work.

After the work is completed and water service has returned to normal, a precautionary boil water notice (PBWN) will be issued.

What to Do

Boil all water used for drinking, cooking, making ice, brushing teeth or washing dishes. Bring water to a rolling boil for at least one minute. Bottled water may be used as an alternative.

The precautionary boil water notice will remain in effect until drinking water test results meet regulatory standards for two consecutive days, in accordance with Florida Administrative Code. The City will notify neighbors when the PBWN has been lifted.

What to Expect

- Temporary low water pressure during the scheduled timeframe.
- Water pressure will return to normal once work is complete.
- A precautionary boil water notice will be issued after the work is completed.
- Properties with water pumps should prepare for reduced water pressure and adjust water use as needed.

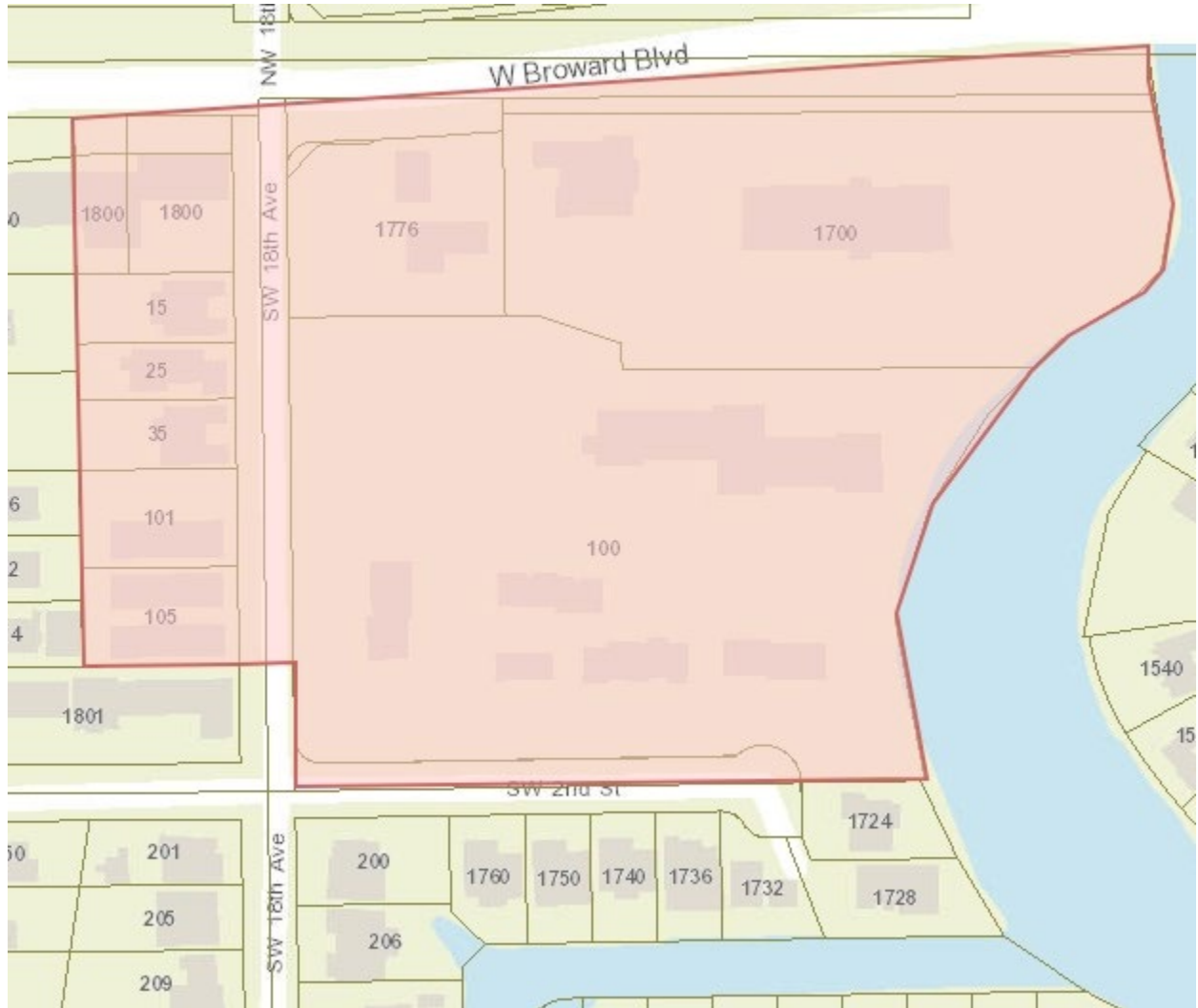
