## IMPORTANT NOTICE!

### Precautionary Waterway Advisory in Effect for the Himmarshee Canal

**June 1, 2026** – Effective immediately, the City of Fort Lauderdale is issuing a precautionary advisory to avoid water-related recreational activities in the Himmarshee Canal as a result of a wastewater discharge into the stormwater system following a break in a nearby sewer force main. The boundaries of the impacted area are:

- **North:** SE 2<sup>nd</sup> Court
- **South:** SE 4<sup>th</sup> Street
- **West:** SE 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue
- **East:** Tarpon Drive

Swimming, fishing, jet-skiing, paddle-boarding, kayaking, canoeing, or engaging in any other water-related activities should be avoided within the advisory area. Water sampling in the affected area will take place daily. The precautionary advisory will be lifted once satisfactory test results are obtained.
